

What is a cooperative?

A cooperative (Bürgerenergiegenossenschaft) is a community-focused, democratically run, and solidarity-based organization. Each member has one vote in the general assembly, regardless of the number of cooperative shares they own. This democratic system can increase people's acceptance of renewable energy. All citizens in the Rhine-Main area have the opportunity to contribute locally to the success of the energy transition. They can support the necessary transformation both ideologically and financially.

Please note:

Joining a cooperative is an investment. Even with careful planning, profits might be lower than expected, and there's a small chance of losing everything. However, members won't be asked to contribute more money than they initially invested. Each member's financial risk is limited to their original contribution.

WHO are we?

FraBeG is the first citizen energy cooperative in Frankfurt. It is a coalition of many citizens both inside and outside the Rhine-Main region.

WHAT do we do?

We plan and implement projects in the field of renewable energy, currently focusing on photovoltaic systems. In addition to photovoltaics, in the long-run we intent to run projects in wind energy, heating, and e-mobility.

WHY do we do it?

We want all citizens to be able to locally contribute to the energy transition. FraBeG provides a framework to enable the energy transition in the hands of citizens, independent of state planning, and to allow citizens to participate in the returns.

Our goal is to produce, distribute, and consume as much CO2-neutral electricity as possible in the region.

HOW do we do it?

We use renewable energy as a local resource and value creation.

WHERE do we come from?

FraBeG is Frankfurt's first citizen energy cooperative, founded in January 2024. It is managed by a three-member board and overseen by a supervisory board. All active members of FraBeG work on a voluntary basis.
